The MAN V8-1300 is an 8-cylinder V engine with 16.2-liter capacity and a maximum power of 1,300 hp (956 kW). Thanks to the power – which is increased by 100 hp (74 kW) – and the retention of the same compact installation dimensions and the same low weight as the V8-1200 variant, the V8-1300 impresses with its extremely high power density of 59 kW per liter capacity.

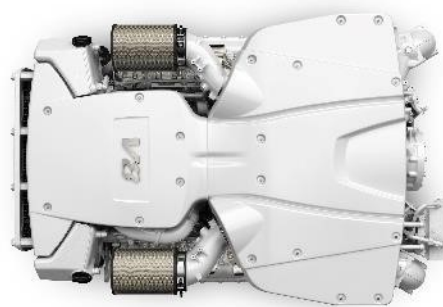
